

Students have homework everyday in Language Arts and Math. Social Studies or Science homework is sent on Tuesday only. It is the students' responsibility to write their daily homework assignments in their school agenda, therefore, it is strongly encouraged for parents to check their child's agenda for specific assignments given weekly.

Below is a basic assignment template used for weekly homework.

(Note: Teachers can modify homework according to the needs of their students. Student agendas will reflect the change in assignments.)

Homework is reviewed daily with the students so, it is essential that it be completed on time.

(Note: Homework counts as 10% of a student's final average grade. If homework is not completed then it will affect a student's conduct grade and final average grade.)
